## NHRC Special Missions Deployed to Investigate the Complaints

The National Human Rights Commission has deployed special missions in the districts of Tarai in eastern and mid-western region to launch investigation on complaints registered at the Commission.

The missions of 28 comprising 21 officers and 7 staff members deployed from the NHRC Central Office and the Regional Offices of Janakpur and Pokhara have been sent to the districts of Saptari, Siraha, Udaypur, Dhanusha, Mahottari, Sarlahi, Bara, Parsa and Makwanpur.

Deployed for the period of two weeks, the Missions have been meeting with the victims, witnesses and the accused persons of the incident. They will also be visiting the indent-spot in the course of investigation.

The NHRC has accomplished investigations over 800 backlog complaints by deploying the missions in Banke and Bardiya districts last Aug/Sep. and in Jhapa, Sunsari, Morang, Kapilvastu, Nawalparasi and Rupendehi last Oct./ Nov., 2012 respectively.

The missions on tour are expected to accomplish over 350 investigations over complaints.

Most complaints registered at the NHRC are related to the killings, disappearance, displacement, property seizure, and violence against women of the conflict period in the country.
