NEPAL: NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 4(3) OF THE COVENANT¹

“.....with reference to his note 0076/2002 dated 22 February 2002 and pursuant to clause 3 of Article 4 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights 1966, [the Permanent Representative of the Kingdom of Nepal] has the honour to inform the Secretary-General that His Majesty’s Government of Nepal lifted the state of emergency in the country, effective from 20 August 2002.”
